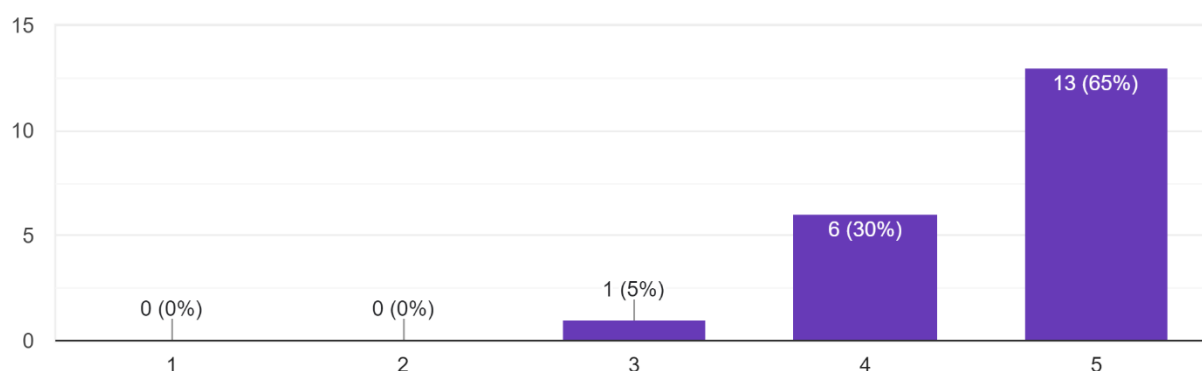

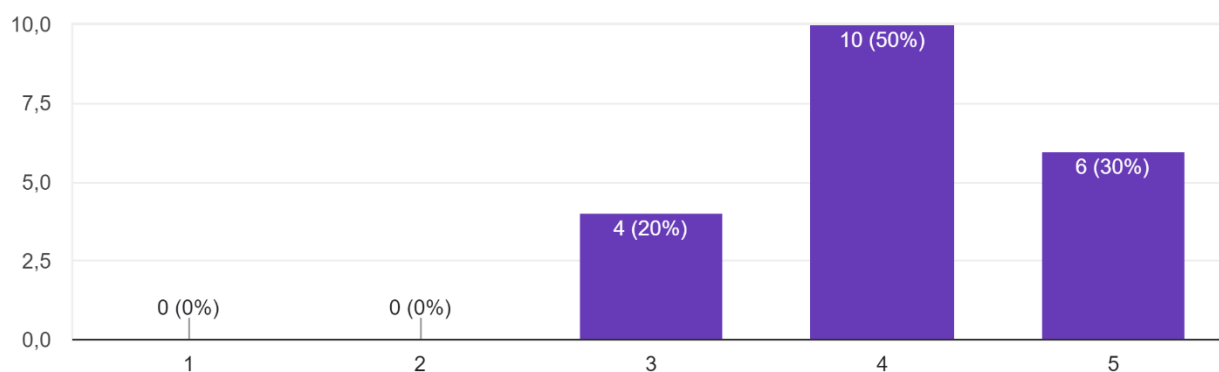
1. How much has this exchange stimulated your interest in the Erasmus+ programme?

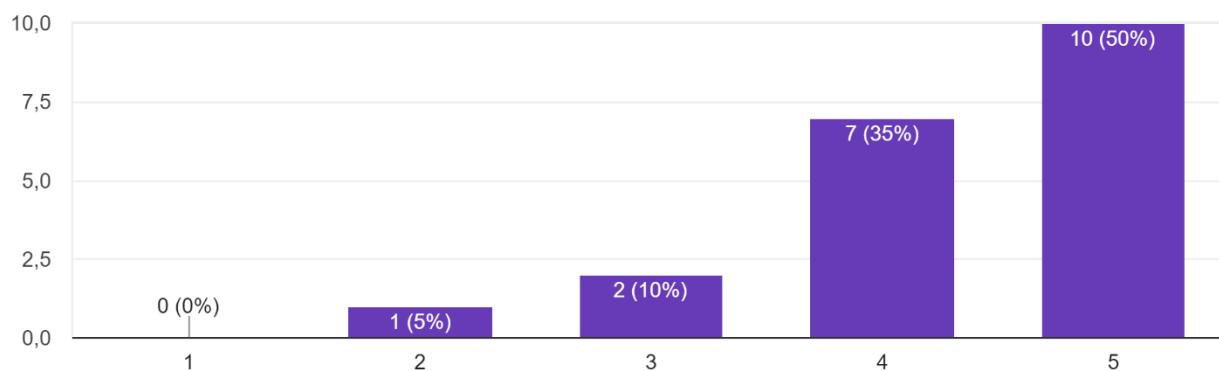
2. How well organized have you found the 1st exchange?

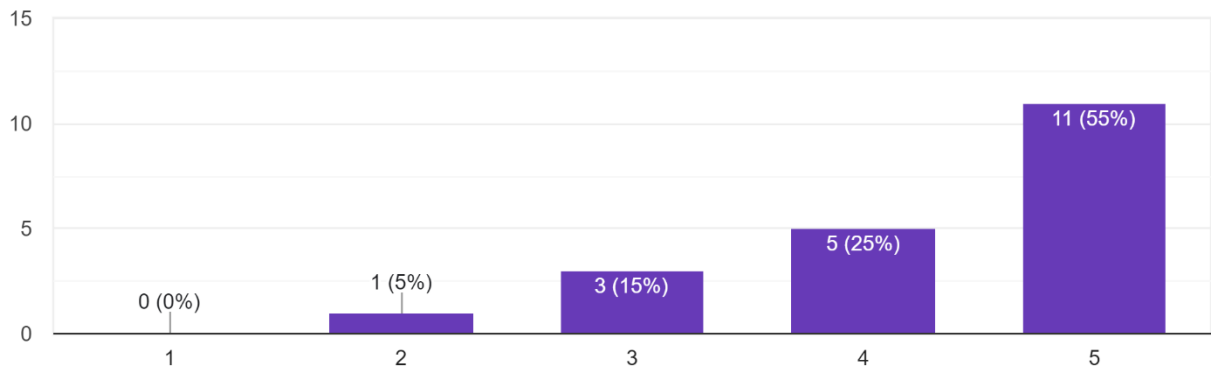

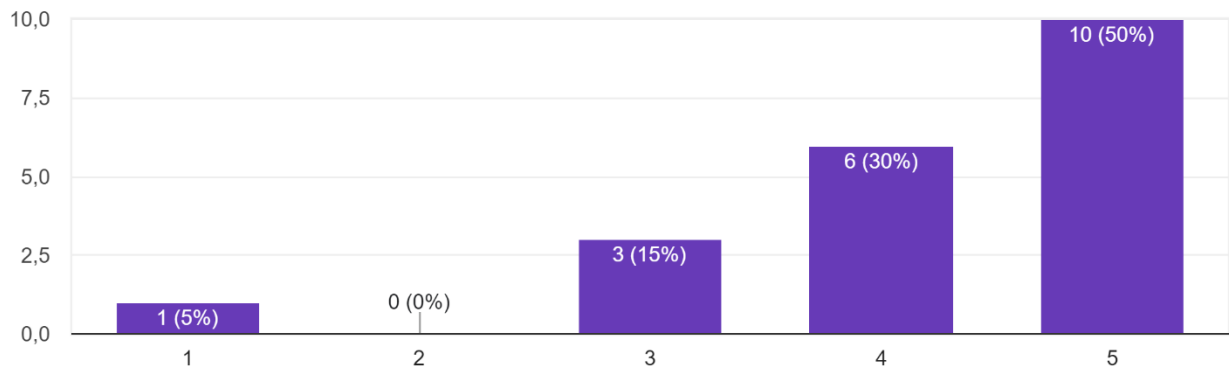
4. Did you find the workshops interesting?

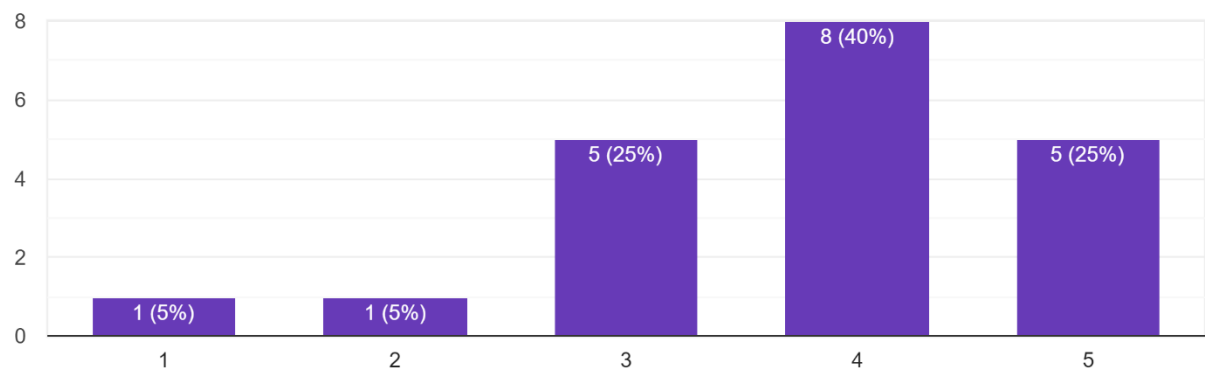
5. Did you find the topics of the workshops relevant to STEAM?

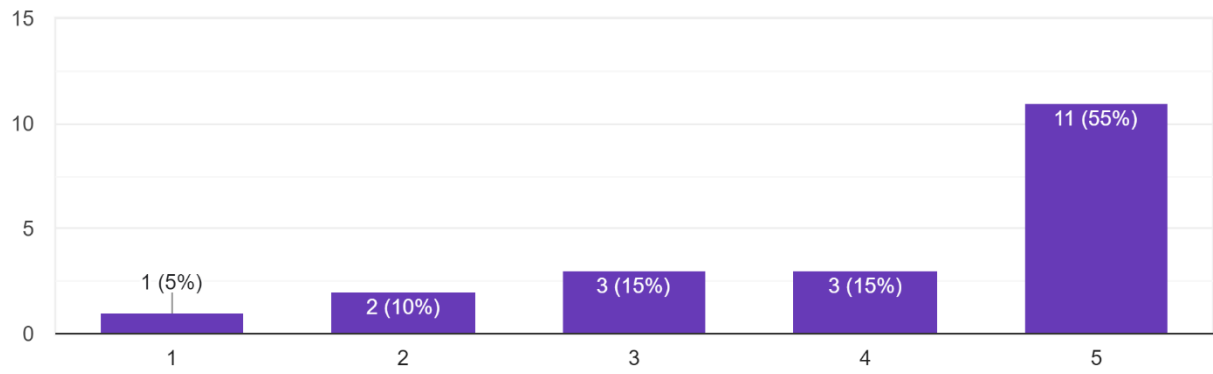
6. Did the workshops/activities provide you with new skills?

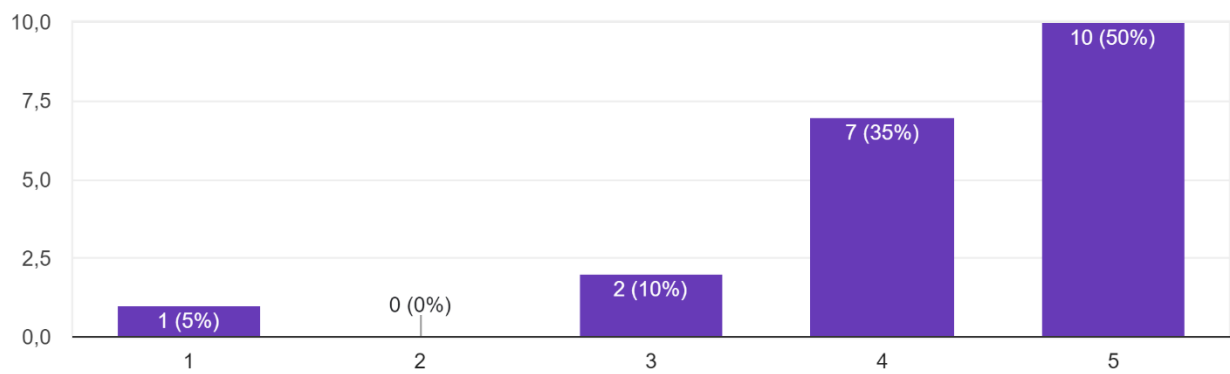
7. Did you get the chance to interact adequately with the foreign partners?

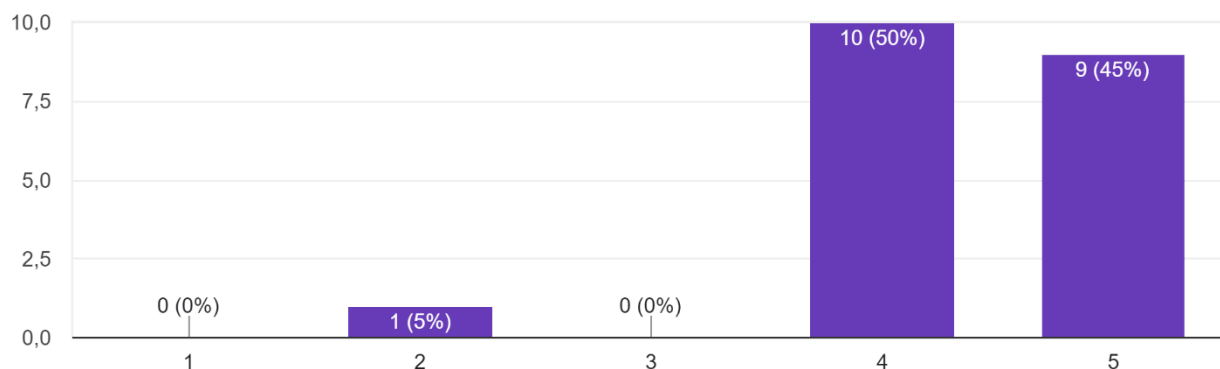
8. Do you think the interaction among partners can motivate you to further study STEAM subjects ?

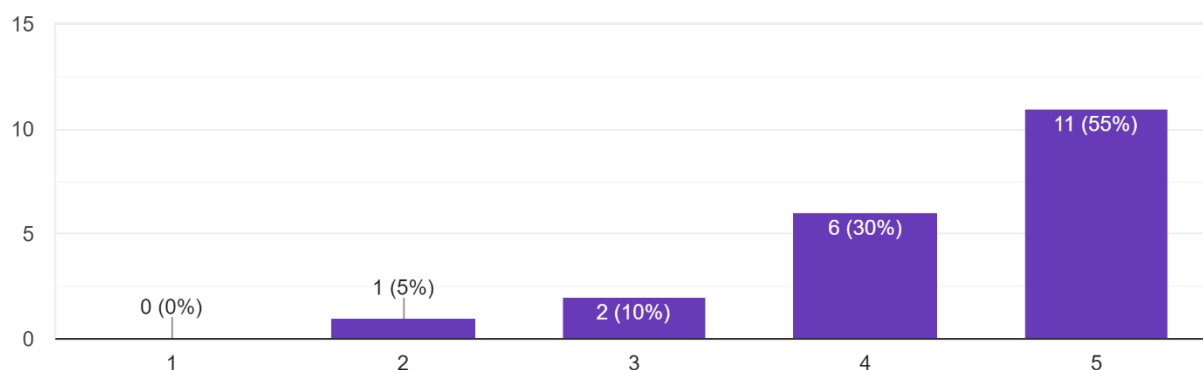
9. Have your English language skills improved thanks to this exchange?
