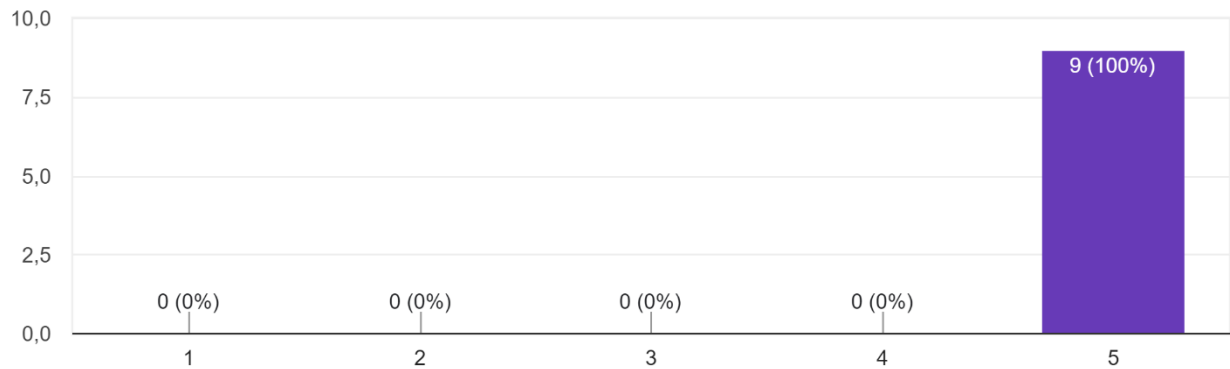

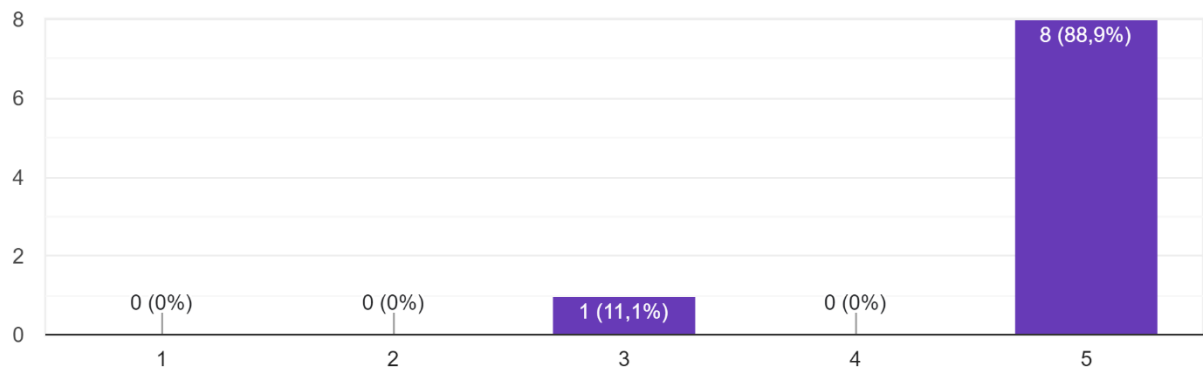
1. How well organized have you found the 1st exchange?

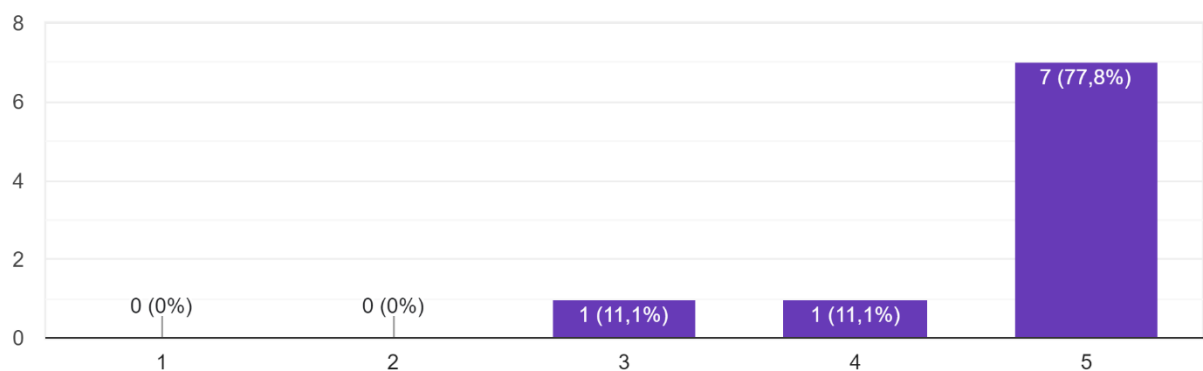
2. Did you enjoy the activities of this exchange?

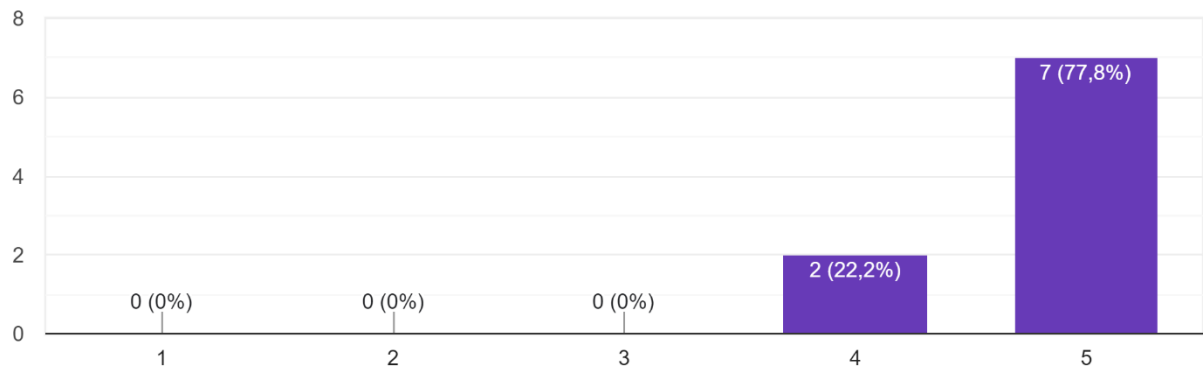
3. Did you find the workshops interesting?

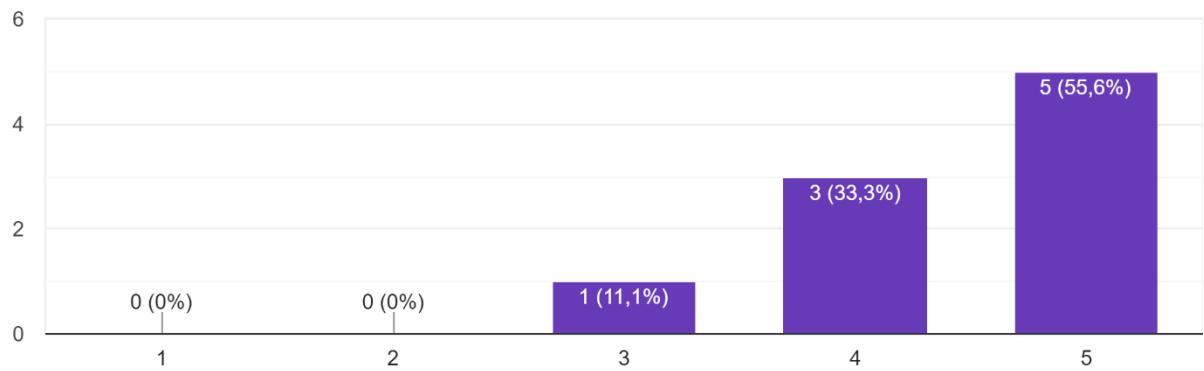
4. Did you find the topics of the workshops relevant to STEAM?

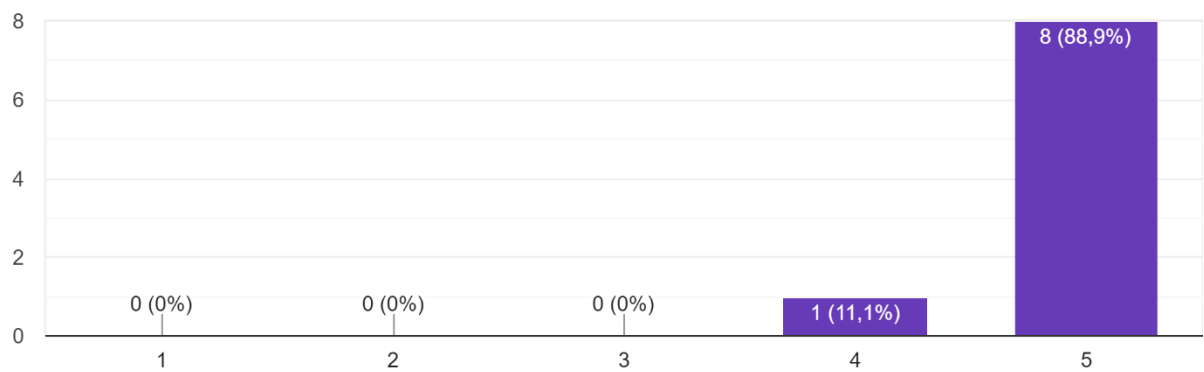
5. Did the workshops/activities provide you with new ideas or best practices?

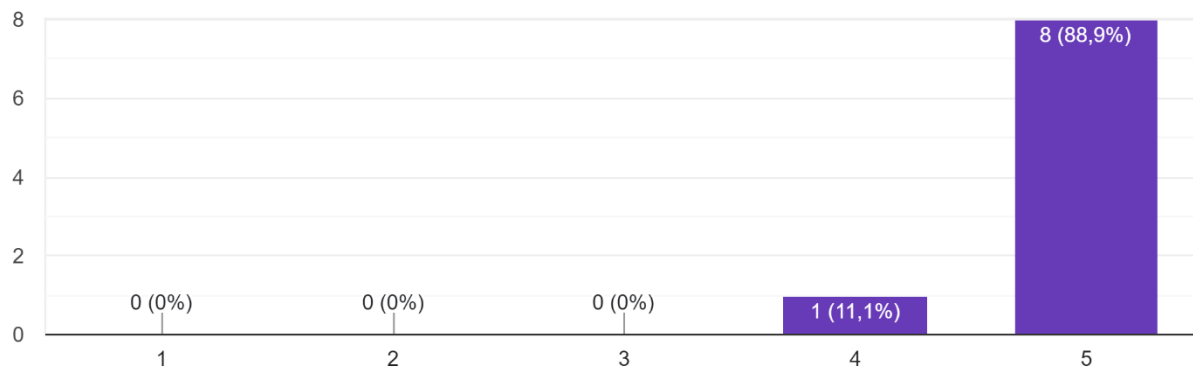

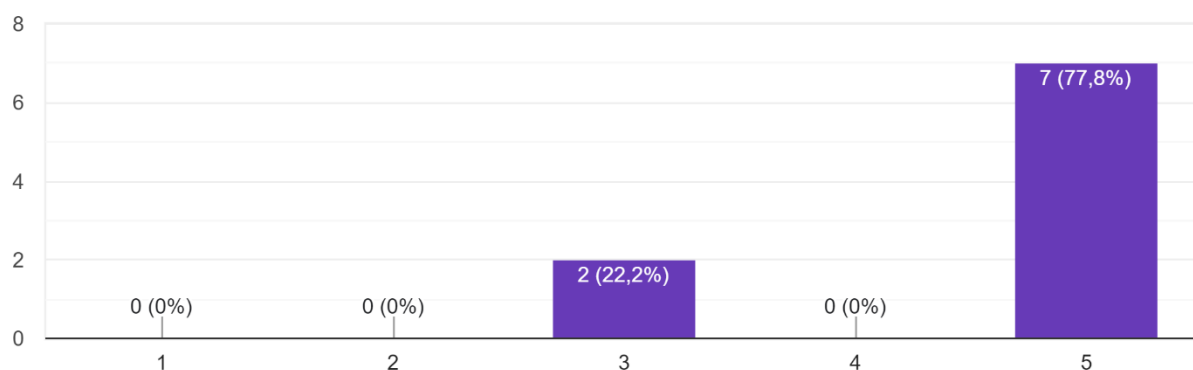
7. Do you think the interaction among partners can motivate you to keep working on your professional development?

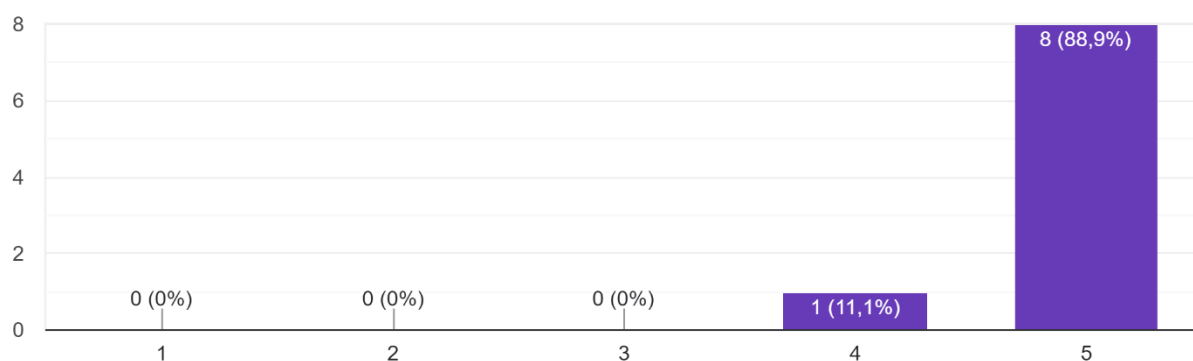
8. Have your English language skills improved thanks to this exchange?
